

Thimble Catcher

My favourite and most useful little bag! My thimble holder, I designed this many years ago as a gift for retreats. These are easy to make, and most of us can use more than one.



You will need:

6 1/2" square of fabric

1" x 1 1/2" piece felt

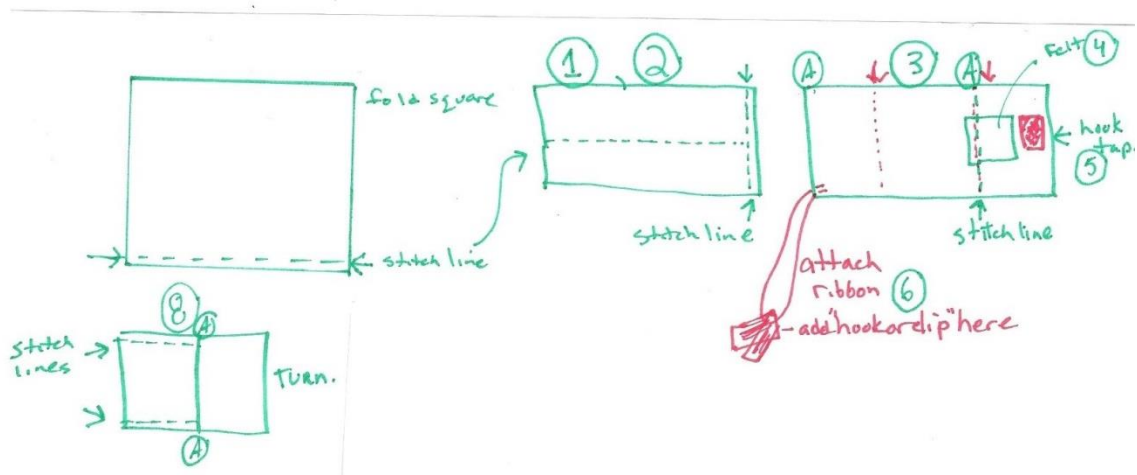

Notions: 8" lengths of ribbon, hook and loop tape or a snap, hook or clip to for attaching to a project.

- 1- Fold the square in half, right sides together and sew along one side
- 2- Roll the seam to the centre, flatten and sew across the bottom
- 3- Turn right sides out, mark at thirds along the length (follow diagram)
- 4- Place the felt piece (for storing needles) on the line marked on the right, sew along the line
- 5- Place the hook tape next to the felt piece, sew securely
- 6- Fold the piece of ribbon, catching the clip, raw edges placed inside open raw edge of fabric. Fold the under the raw edge in and sew across the end, securing the ribbon.
- 7- Fold over at the marked line on the right, matching A to A. Note where the matching the hook tape should be to close the case, open and sew in place.
- 8- Fold the A to A again, and sew up both sides, securing the ends. Turn right side out with the seam to the inside. Press.
